Some Christmas traditions in Ireland include a Christmas morning swim at The Forty Foot in Sandycove, Co. Dublin or on St Stephen's Day, the day after Christmas, when they have the Wren Boys Procession, horse racing or partaking in a pint or two at the local pub while watching the matches.

As we prepare for Christmas let us be mindful of the true meaning of this Holy Day and pray for those that are no longer with us to celebrate Christ's Mass.

The deadline to vote is December 31, 2019.




This house stood where the Hibernian's car park is on Watertown St.
