Christmas in Ireland lasts from Christmas Eve to the feast of the Epiphany on January 6, known as Little Christmas. In Ireland, Little Christmas is also called Women's Christmas (Nollaig na mBan). Traditionally Women get the day off and men do the housework and cooking! Have fun ladies!

Some Christmas traditions in Ireland include a Christmas morning swim at The Forty Foot in Sandycove, Co. Dublin or on St Stephen's Day, the day after Christmas, when they have the Wrenboys Procession, horse racing or partaking in a pint or two at the local pub while watching the matches.

As we prepare for Christmas let us be mindful of the true meaning of this Holy Day and pray for those that are no longer with us to celebrate Christ's Mass.

#### US will push EU and UK for deal on protocol, says senator

Senator Chris Murphy, a member of the US Foreign Relations Committee, also said he would not support any bilateral trade agreement between the US and the UK while outstanding issues with the post-Brexit protocol still remained to be resolved. The Democrat senator is in the North where he met with political leaders at Stormont. Speaking at Stormont, he said: "I am here on behalf of Republicans and Democrats in the United States Senate who are interested in continuing our legacy of friendship with Northern Ireland.

"This is a critical moment for Northern Ireland as we are watching the negotiation play out over the future of the protocol. "We want to make sure that the protocol is moved forward in a way that benefits all of the people of Northern Ireland. "To my mind, it would not be good for Northern Ireland if Article 16 was invoked, which could ultimately provoke a crisis, a trade war which would act to the detriment of the people here." He added: "This is a negotiation between Britain and the European Union, but the United States, having been an important player in the Good Friday Agreement, wants to make sure that nothing happens with respect to Britain's departure from the European Union that compromises peace here in Northern Ireland. With regard to Brexit and the Northern Ireland protocol, we in the AOH feel we are doing God's work and have righteous on our side. However, it is important to know the position of your adversary. To this end, I share this article, "The Irish Protocol: Versailles for slow learners", which essentially equates the NI protocol with the treaty of Versailles at the end of WW1 when the allies (at the behest of the French) imposed extreme peace terms on Germany that experts correctly warned would ruin the German economy and undermine its democracy.
