A message from Political Education Chair Rick Connell

This past Sunday, Jan 30th was the 50th anniversary of the Bloody Sunday massacre. Numerous articles are appearing to explain and educate people about this pivotal day in Irish History. Some useful articles include the following

- <u>Remembering the horror of Bloody Sunday 50 years on</u> (Irish Central).
- <u>'Bloody Sunday' Still Scars Northern Ireland 50 Years On</u> (USA Today).
- Our front pages: How the Irish Independent covered the Bloody Sunday Massacre in 1972 (Irish Independent).
- <u>Bloody Sunday: 50 years on</u> (Irish Times). This excellent compilation of articles notes "Far more people died because of Bloody Sunday than those who were murdered on the day."

Representative Keating (D-MA 9th District) submitted a resolution in the House of Representatives to commemorate the 50th anniversary of Bloody Sunday.

Closer to the home sod, the European Union is seeking to resolve the impasse with Britain over Northern Ireland's trading arrangements <u>by</u> <u>the end of February</u>, aware that campaigning then begins for the province's assembly, the EU's chief negotiator told lawmakers on 20-Jan. A subsequent article cited Feb 21st as the deadline. See article "<u>NI Protocol:</u> <u>First Minister sets February 21st as potential talks deadline</u>"

European Commission Vice President Maros Sefcovic, who oversees post-Brexit relations with Britain, told a closed session of European Parliament members that a window of opportunity was likely to close by the end of February, according to attendees at the meeting and those briefed on it.

Foreign secretary Liz Truss traveled to Brussels on 24-Jan after setting a new Northern Ireland Protocol deadline for agreeing on a deal with the EU. The new date has been set for <u>the end of February</u> to come up with a compromise on the post-Brexit arrangements for the area.

Britain continues to press the US for a trade deal to remove Tariffs on steel sent to the US. However, it is assumed by many that the US is deferring progress on the tariffs as leverage over the NI protocols: a point recognized by all. This is raising the tension in the US. Labour MP Sir Mark Hendrick (Preston) asked: "Given the fact that the Prime Minister is playing fast and loose with security policy on Northern Ireland, in particular the way he is doing his best to trash the Northern Ireland Protocol, <u>what</u> <u>chance does she think we have of getting those tariffs dropped</u>?"


